

Notice of Race

2017 USVMYG Traditional Sailing Craft regatta

June 17-18, 2017

Sponsored by the US Vintage Model Yacht Group and

hosted by the Marbleheaders of Spring Lake MYC

Eligibility: Skippers of the RC Skipjack 48, schooner models over and under 50” and Unrestricted class models. Membership in the US Vintage Model Yacht Group is mandatory and membership in the American Model Yachting Association is encouraged.

Location: Southeast end of Spring Lake (intersection of Warren and Monmouth Avenues) in the town of Spring Lake, N.J. 07762.

Rules:

- Racing will be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS), as modified by Appendix E, the prescriptions of US Sailing when they apply, and the Regatta Sailing Instructions.
- Current USVMYG rules for the Skipjack 48 (November, 2016), Schooner Class (November 2016) and the Unrestricted Class (February, 2017) available on the USVMYG website: <http://pages.swcp.com/usvmyg/>

Entry: Eligible boats and skippers are entered upon receipt of completed Entry Form and entry fees **no later than May 31, 2017**.

Schedule:*

Saturday, June 17, 2017

9:00 to 9:30 am: Check in.

10:00 am: Skippers meeting followed by Skipjack 48 first race.

12:00 to 1:00 pm: Lunch break and Skipjack 48 awards.

1:00 pm: Unrestricted Class skippers meeting followed by first race and awards.

3:00 pm: Racing ends for the day.

Sunday, June 18, 2017

9:00 to 9:30 am: Check in.

10:00 am: Skippers meeting for all schooners followed by first race.

12:00 to 1:00 pm: Lunch break.

1:00 pm: Schooner racing continues to about 2:30, with awards to follow.

***Regatta Schedule:** The schedule may be modified at the discretion of the Regatta Committee based on fleet registrations, weather and general sailing conditions.

Racing Format: Single fleet

Scoring: Low point scoring system. One throw-out for every six races.

Prizes: Trophies will be awarded to the top three skippers in skipjack and schooner fleets that field six or more boats and Unrestricted Class skippers will receive participation awards.
